Recognizing the Armenian Genocide Poster Assignment

The Objective: There are 207 sovereign states in the world, yet **only 21** countries have recognized the Genocide of the Armenians. Your goal is to get the world to recognize the atrocities committed by the Ottoman Empire against the Armenian population, was in fact a Genocide.



Your Task:

Step One: Poster Creation

Create a poster to *raise awareness* about the Armenian Genocide. The poster should reflect a clear message and content so as to provide enough information to the reader/viewer.

Step Two: Explanation:

Written rationale: Along with your poster, each person must submit a one-paragraph written rationale describing the overall message the poster should convey, and how the poster relates to specific details that you learned about the Armenian Genocide.
