

## *Girl, Interrupted*

*Girl, Interrupted* is a movie about a young woman's, Susannah, journey through recovery at a psychiatric hospital in the 1960s. After what her parents' feel was a suicide attempt, Susannah finds herself in the hospital with a diagnosis of Borderline Personality Disorder. Throughout her stay, Susannah meets Lisa who is considered to have Anti-Social Personality Disorder and Daisy who is a recovering anorexic.

After viewing the movie, your task is to write a one to two page response to their diagnosis from one of the roles listed below. Your diary entry should fully take on the persona of the chosen role and fully demonstrate the reaction and feelings that individual may have about their diagnosis. Your response should include details of the disorder as well as their reaction to what they are said to be suffering from.
