The HSB4UI Unit 3 test will consist of two questions. You will be allowed to bring on <u>ONE</u> 8.5 x 11 sheet that <u>YOU</u> have prepared (no photocopies of notes, texts or a friend's sheet, no phones, no laptops.) You will staple your sheet to the test at the end of class so Mr. Chard can take a look at what you prepared.

The first question on the test is:

1. Does popular culture help, harm or reflect who we are as a society today?

Specifically, does this type of entertainment adversely effect us, help us by providing a catharsis for violence and aggression, or simply show who we are as a cultural mirror?

Focus on more than one form of entertainment and focus on examples examined in class.

The second question will be about demographics. You will have a choice of two questions (you only have to answer one of them.) They will be about TWO of the following topics, chosen at random by Mr. Chard:

- Sandwich generation (we examined two articles in class)
- The Census (we examined one article in class)
- Midlife and Quarterlife Crisis (we did a note in class)
- Boom, Bust and Echo (we examined a chart in class HINT choose one generation you think has done well and one that has faced significant challenges and study them)
