

## Russian Revolution Poster Assignment CHY4UI Chard

You are living somewhere in Russia in 1916. You are concerned about the current political situation. In your group, <u>create a poster</u> for a movement whose aim is to encourage a change OR to maintain the dominant social order under the Czar.

**Examples:** 

You might be a communist revolutionary. You might belong to a group of military officers. You might represent the Russian Orthodox Church. You might be an anti-war activist. You might be advocating land reform. You may be a veteran of the 1905 war with Japan.

Whatever your "cause," keep the following in mind:

- 1. Be sure it actually "fits" with early twentieth-century Russia (avoid anachronisms.)
- 2. Try to include as much accurate detail as possible (draw on notes, the textbook, etc.)
- 3. You are creating propoganda the message should be clear and obvious, don't make it too complicated.
